We are an International Sisterhood of women, ages 7 to 107.

We are ordinary women who are strengthened through the discipline of a Rule of Life and supported through the companionship of our sisters.

We are all at different stages of our Christian journey – some have just begun and some have been on this path for a long time. No special spiritual attributes are needed to become a Daughter – only a sincere desire to draw nearer to God and to help others do the same.

This past summer, about 550 Daughters (both Senior and Junior) from around the world met in Baltimore for our Triennial which had been postponed from 2021. There were, altogether, eleven Daughters from Province I, three from our Diocese of WMA, three from Diocese of MA and six from CT. After the past two years of Zoom meetings, it was a joy to be together again with other Daughters! We returned with more ideas and plans to enrich our chapters and inspired to continue reaching out to share our faith and our Order to women and girls.

In WMA, we are planning a new Discernment /Study for adult women to begin this Fall, via Zoom. This will enable women from around the Diocese to join together and explore their own faith and to discern whether they are called to be a Daughter of the King.
